


















When you click on the “Import” element, the lesson import card opens:





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


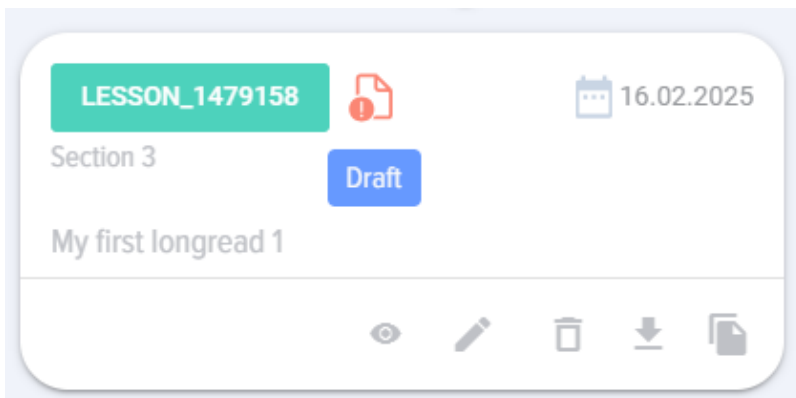
The template looks like this:
